Pursuant to Section 12(I) of the NSLA, 42 U.S.C. 1760(I) (Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act), the Colorado Food Cluster Inc. would like to submit a proposal for waivers with consideration to operate a three year pilot program under the Child Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) and Summer Food Service Program (SFSP), operating as an At-Risk Afterschool Sponsor of Centers during the school year, serving milk, snacks, dinners and providing enrichment activities. This submission is filed in accordance with memo <a href="SP 15-2018">SP 15-2018</a>, CACFP 12-2018, SFSP 05-2018 "Child Nutrition Program Waiver Request Guidance and Protocol- Revised", issued by Angela Kline, May 24, 2018.
